This is a beginning skill building class for adults and children. We will be making different projects each week. You will learn a variety of skills such as sewing around curves and corners, inserting zippers, gathering, inserting elastic, fancy stitching, inserting buttons and buttonholes, installing snaps, basting, and how to follow a simple pattern. Participants should have a basic knowledge of their sewing machine (how to thread and sew a straight stitch).
