Join us in making this fun Breezy Day spring/summer quilt measuring 42" x 42". It is another one of the fun projects in the book Mini Wonderful Curves using the Mini Quick Curve ruler. (book required)

Supply List:

Mini Wonderful Curves book QCR Mini Ruler (QCRM)

Sewing machine in good working order with cord and foot pedal

Basic sewing supplies (pins, scissors, seam ripper, bobbins, etc.)

Rotary cutter, mat and ruler

Machine Needle Type: 75/11 quilting or 70/10 Microtex

Thread Type(s): Neutral color (Aurifil) for piecing

Fabric requirements: 5 assorted aqua fat quarters (or colors of your choice)

1 pink fat quarter (or color of your choice)

2 yards background fabric (I am actually using a white background)

1-2/3 yards backing fabric

1/2 yard binding fabric

Notions: Rotary cutter and ruler plus QCR ruler

Thread to coordinate with chosen fabrics or a neutral which will mix well with all of them.

I like to use a 50 weight cotton (Aurifil)

Seam ripper

Quilter's pins (suggestion: flat head, very fine pins)

Needles (sharp) for sewing machines (75/11 works well for piecing and 90 Topstitch works well for quilting)

Walking foot if you have one

Quilting Pins or 505 Temporary Spray Adhesive

Marking pen, pencil or chalk

Small iron and ironing pad
