Supply List:

Butterfly Blooms Quilt Pattern by Cozy Quilt Designs designed by Georgette Dell’Orco

Sewing machine in good working order with cord and foot pedal

Basic sewing supplies (pins, scissors, seam ripper, bobbins, etc.)

Rotary cutter, mat and ruler

Machine Needle Type: 75/11 quilting needles or 70/10 Microtex sharp needles for piecing - suggest Aurifil

Thread Type(s): 50 wt neutral color piecing thread (beige or gray works well also)

Fabric requirements: Fabric Requirements: Refer to pattern

From one fabric:

Block background: 1 3/8 yards

Note: or 25 2-1/2” x WOF strips (jelly roll or fat quarters are an option)

Sample used: 3 2-1/2” x WOF strips each of 10 different fabrics (about 1/3 yard)

Border 1: 1/2 yard

Border 3: 1 1/8 yards

Different fabric:

Border 2: 1/2 yard

Backing: 4 1/8 yards

Binding: 1/2 yard

Notions: 1/4” piecing foot or quilting foot with guide (recommended) OR open toe foot if you prefer to piece with this

90 Topstitch needles for quilting - quilting not to be done in class / only covers quilt top

Fabric marking pencil or other marking pencil such as Friction

Stripology ruler if you have one

Square up ruler to cover block size 10-1/2 x 10-1/2

6x 24 ruler

Thread for quilting - quilting done at home

Rotary cutting mat (18” x 24” recommended)

Rotary cutter (45 mm recommended)

Other: May bring small iron and ironing pad if you want
