



## Church Window Quilt with J'Ann McEwen - **NEW**

This fun “stained glass” like quilt measures 53” x 62 1/2”. Surprisingly, there are no “Y” seams! If you are up for something a little different, this is a good class for you. **Intermediate, \$45**

### **Supply List:**

Church Window Quilt Pattern by Brittany Lloyd (Lo & Behold Stitchery)  
Sewing machine in good working order with cord and foot pedal  
Basic sewing supplies (pins, scissors, seam ripper, bobbins, etc.)  
Rotary cutter, mat and ruler  
Iron and pressing pad

**Machine Needle Type:** 75/11 quilting needles or 70/10 Microtex sharp needles for piecing 50 wt neutral color piecing thread (beige or gray works well)

**Thread Type(s):** 50 wt neutral color piecing thread (beige or gray works well also)

### **Fabric requirements:** Fabric Requirements:

Main fabric: 35 F8's OR 18 GQ's OR 12 1/4 yard cuts OR 6 1/2 yard cuts OR 2 3/4-yards — depending on how many different fabric you want to use. In my sample, I used 6 1/2-yard cuts.

Sashing: 7/8 yard

Backing: 3 1/2 yards

Binding: 1/2 yard

**Notions:** 1/4” piecing foot or quilting foot with guide (recommended) OR open toe foot if you prefer to piece with this

Fabric marking pencil or other marking pencil such as Frixion

Rulers of your choice but make sure they have a marking for the 45 degree angles (6 x 24” or I like the 6 x 12” ruler)

Stripology ruler if you have one and like to use for cutting sashing

Best Press

Rotary cutting mat (18” x 24”)

Rotary cutter (45 mm)

**Other:** We will do the cutting during the first class. If you choose to cut your sashing at home, I would suggest that you cut as follows: the 3/4" x 8 1/2" as suggested to be cut at 3/4" x 9" and the 1" x 7" as suggested to be cut at 1" x 7 1/2"

Please consider the fabric you are choosing for the windows since there will be a seam down the middle. Even if it is the same fabric, you will want to assess how it will look when pieced together.
