Supply list:

Sewing machine in good working condition - with foot pedal, power cord, and manual (if available)

1/4" foot, walking foot, button foot

All purpose thread to match fabric

Decorative thread for quilting place mat

Universal needle 80/12, embroidery needle 11/75

Basic sewing supplies

Playful Place Mats book by Vickie Clontz of Annie's Keepsakes (available through Lakeshore Sewing)

For 4 place mats and napkins you will need 1 1/2 yd of 2 different fabrics and 1/2 yd of non-fusible fleece.

Or instructions given are for making 1 place mat and napkin:

1/2 yd of dark blue print fabric for place mat back, body, and napkin loop

14" x 12" piece of light blue print fabric for head and fin

18" x 18" square of coordinating fabric for napkin and of non-fusible fleece

3/4" black button, per place mat

18" x 18" tracing paper

Fabric marking pen and pencil

Rotary cutter

Ruler 6" x 15"

Hand sewing needle

Point turner
