Supply List:

Lickety Split Log Cabin pattern by Cut Loose Press

Creative Grids Log Cabin Trim Tool CGRJAW1

Sewing machine in good working order with cord and foot pedal

Basic sewing supplies (pins, scissors, seam ripper, bobbins, etc.)

Rotary cutter, mat and ruler

Machine Needle Type: 75/11 quilting or 70/10 Microtex

Thread Type(s): Neutral color fabric for piecing (preferably 100% cotton) (recommend Aurifil)

Fabric requirements: A variety of 6 prints for logs — 6 light fat quarters

A variety of dark prints for logs - 6 dark fat quarters

Block Centers, Inner Border and Binding - 1 yd.

Outer Border - 2/3 yd.

Backing - 9 fat quarters or 1 5/8 yds of one fabric

Also note that there are actually 6 different prints for both the light and dark fabrics — and not 5 as indicated on the pattern.

Notions: Markin pen, pencil or chalk; Gizmo or other thread cutter only if you already have one

Other: Also note that there are actually 6 different prints for both the light and dark fabrics — and not 5 as indicated on the pattern.

If you feel comfortable you may cut your fabric at home. Please note: Cut your strips at least 1-3/4" wide as suggested on the ruler rather than 1-1/2" wide as suggested in the pattern.
