

Pillow with Piping with Julie Norkoli - **NEW**



Learn how to make and put in piping in this advanced beginning sewing class. Your pillow can be as simple or as fancy as you wish. Participants should have a basic knowledge of their sewing machine (how to thread and sew a straight stitch).

Supply list:

Sewing machine in good working order

Piping foot to fit your sewing machine

Fabric scissors

Cutting Mat, Rotary Cutter and Cutting Ruler

Pillow Fabric – ½ yard quilter's cotton fabric or 2 fat quarters

Front rectangle 12.5" x 16.5" – cut prior to class – can be pieced or cut from one piece of fabric

Back 12.5" x 8" and 12.5" x 13" – cut prior to class

Piping Fabric – 1.25" wide by 2 yards, cut on bias and sewn together – 1 fat quarter will be enough – cut prior to class if possible – call with questions

12" x 16" pillow form

¼" Cotton or polyester piping – 2 yards

Size 90 microtex needle

Sewing thread to match fabric
