



## Winterberry Tree Skirt with J'Ann McEwen

This is a fun Christmas tree skirt to make whether you use specialty fabrics or scraps! Check out your stash and see what you have. Two options are available: 2-1/2" squares as in pattern or we can do by strip sets. **Confident Beginner, \$40**

### Supply list:

Winterberry Tree Skirt pattern #CJC 4094-12

Sewing machine in good working order with cord and foot pedal

Basic sewing supplies (pins, scissors, seam ripper, bobbins, etc.)

Rotary cutter, mat and ruler

**Machine Needle Type:** 75/11 quilting needles or 70/10 Microtex sharp needles for piecing #90 Topstitch for quilting

**Thread Type(s):** 50 wt neutral color piecing thread (beige or gray works well also)

**Fabric requirements:** Fabric requirements are listed on the pattern itself as there are 12 fabrics. Also listed are fabric requirements for batting and ribbon.

6" square piece of freezer paper

Please look at the pattern. It calls for cutting small squares. I have made it this way and by strip piecing so there is another option.

**Notions:** 1/4" piecing foot or quilting foot with guide (recommended) or open toe foot — your choice

Fabric marking pencil or other marking pencil

Rotary cutter (45 mm recommended)

Rotary cutting mat (18" x 24" recommended)

Rulers (I suggest a 6 1/2" x 24" and others of your choosing) I also used an 8 1/2" x 24" ruler — bring if you have one

Stripology ruler if you have one
