Supply List:

Book or pattern: Mini Wonderful Curves Book

Quick Curve Mini Ruler (QCRM)

Sewing machine in good working order with cord and foot pedal

Basic sewing supplies (pins, scissors, seam ripper, bobbins, etc.)

Rotary cutter, mat and ruler

Iron and pressing pad

Machine Needle Type: 75/11 quilting needles or 70/10 Microtex sharp needles for piecing #90 Topstitch for quilting

Thread Type(s): 50 wt neutral color piecing thread (beige or gray works well also) (Aurifil)

Fabric requirements: 8 fat quarters of assorted yellow prints for flowers

4 10" squares of assorted green prints for leaves

4 fat quarters of assorted gray prints for flower centers

1 yard each of background fabric in light blue, light gray, medium gray and white

4 yards baking fabric (although this will not be done in class)

1/2 yard binding fabric

Notions: 1/4" piecing foot or quilting foot with guide (recommended) OR open toe foot if you prefer to piece with this

Fabric marking pencil or other marking pencil such as Friction

6 x 24" ruler

Thread for quilting
