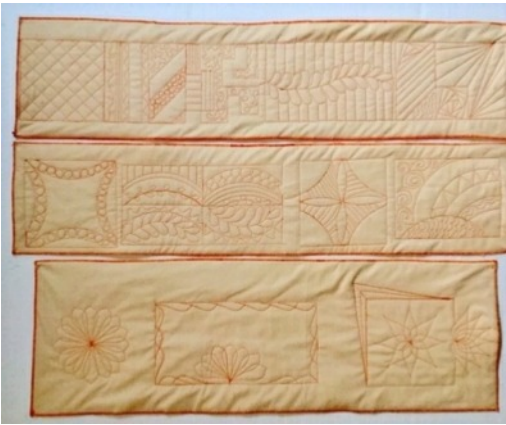


Quilting with Rulers #1 with J'Ann McEwen

Supply List:

Sewing machine in good working order with cord and foot pedal

Basic sewing supplies (pins, scissors, seam ripper, bobbins, etc.)

Rotary cutter, mat and ruler

Iron and pressing pad

Machine Needle Type: 80 or 90 Topstitch needles

Thread Type(s): decorative or colored thread to practice with

Fabric requirements: Three muslin sandwiches measuring approximately 22" x 22" (A sandwich consists of one layer of muslin for top, layer of batting and second layer of muslin for back.) They may be pinned together (safety pins) or sprayed with 505 Spray

Batting:

Notions: Ruler Foot and 12" arc ruler if it comes with the Westelee foot — the store can help you determine whether you have a high shank or low shank machine which will be important when you purchase the foot.

Westelee Sampler Set of rulers

Sew Steady table if you have one

Gloves if you have them
