

Trellis Quilt with Beth Ann Williams - **NEW**

We'll tackle this fun quilt by Cluck, Cluck, Sew (pattern purchase required) over a relaxed 3 weeks. Week 1: Finalizing fabric selection and arrangement (we'll explore multiple options), plus cutting tips & tricks. Week 2: Making the blocks (the class is based on the crib/smaller throw size, but you can make any size you like.) Week 3: Assembling the quilt blocks and suggestions for quilting. The sample quilt measures 48" x 56" without borders. Other sizes include a larger Throw, Twin, and Queen/King. This pattern is Jelly Roll, Layer Cake, and Fat Quarter friendly.

How Zoom classes will work:

- You do not need to have a Zoom account to participate in a Zoom class.
- You can register and pay for Zoom classes through the stores (by phone or in person), just like an in-person class.
- Supply lists will be available in-store and online.
- You must supply a current email address when you sign up so that instructors will be able to send out invitations to join the class.
- Teachers will email the invitation links to join the class at least 24 hours in advance. There will be no class refunds with less than 48 hours notice.
- If you are new to Zoom, please check into the class ahead of time and follow the prompts to set up audio and video.

PLEASE NOTE: Zoom seems to work best in conjunction with Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, or Chromium Edge.

Supply List:

Trellis Quilt pattern by Cluck, Cluck, Sew (required)

Sewing machine in good working order

Quarter-inch foot

Sewing machine needles - *My preference for this class is the Schmetz Quilting needle*

Thread & extra bobbins (wound) - *I recommend a high quality 50 wt. mercerized cotton thread such as Auriful 50 wt. cotton thread.*

Scissors, seam ripper, pins

Rotary cutter, mat and ruler

I'll also demo the Creative Grids Stripology Ruler for those who want to try it.

Iron and pressing pad or ironing board

Masking tape/Painter's tape

Optional, but strongly recommended: Wonder Clips

Fabric as listed on the pattern.

Note: the sample quilt, which finished at 48" x 56" BEFORE adding borders*, called for **7 fat quarters and 2 yards of background fabric.**

When laying out my quilt, I chose to cut one additional 2.5" strip of the red striped fabric and subbed that for one of the other colors in order to make the pinwheel in the bottom left corner. Be sure to buy a little extra of one fabric if you'd like to do the same.

*Borders are not included in the pattern, but we will discuss options.
