Supply List:

Quick & Easy Block Tool Book by Liz Aneloski, Kandy Petersen & Debbie Rodgers

Machine in good working order

1/4" piecing foot or quilting foot with guide (recommended) OR open toe clear foot if you prefer to piece with this

75/11 quilting needles or 70/10 Microtex sharp needles

50 wt neutral color piecing thread (beige or gray works well also)

Fabric marking pencil or other marking pencil

Rotary cutter (45 mm recommended)

Basic sewing supplies including:

Scissors

Seam ripper

Straight pins

Rotary cutting mat (18" x 24" recommended)

Rulers (I suggest a 6 1/2" x 24" and others of your choosing)

Stripology Ruler for the 2 1/2" squares if you have one already

8 1/2" Bias square ruler (available through Lakeshore)

*If you feel comfortable, you can cut your fabric prior to class.
