



School of Sewing Part 3 with Susan Barr

Wow, look how much you have learned so far! 4 projects left in the book! Let's finish learning in this fun 4-class series! We will meet once a month for 3 hours. Learn to make an Essential Tote Bag, Pleated Purse, Set The Table Place Mats and My First Quilt. Classes are based on the popular book School of Sewing by Shea Henderson.



All students MUST have completed School of Sewing Parts 1 and 2 before taking Part 3.

Supply List for all sessions:

Book: School of Sewing by Shea Henderson

Sewing machine in good working order with cord and foot pedal

Basic sewing supplies (pins, scissors, seam ripper, bobbins, etc.)

Rotary cutter, mat and ruler

Machine Needle Type: Universal needle 80/12

Thread Type(s): 100% polyester thread to match fabric

Interfacing/Stabilizers:

Essential tote bag: 2 yards woven fusible interfacing, 2/3 yard fusible fleece.

Pleated purse: 4 yards woven fusible interfacing, 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" fusible fleece scrap.

Fabric requirements: Quilting cotton for exterior and lining for all 4 projects.

Tote bag: solid style 2/3 yard for exterior and lining, 1/2 yard for long straps, 1/4 yard for short straps.

Pleated purse: 1 1/2 yard exterior, 1/2 yard lining, 1/4 yard pocket.

Place mats: 1 yard main, 1 1/2 yard backing, 3/4 yard binding.

My first Quilt: 1 1/4 yards each of fabric A and B, 3 yards backing, 1/3 yard binding.

Batting requirements:

Place mats: 1 yard batting.

My first quilt: low loft batting crib size.

Notions:

Essential tote bag: marking pen, hand sewing needle, optional ditch or edgestitch foot.

Pleated purse: 3/4" magnetic snap, 9" all purpose zipper, zipper presser foot, marking pen, optional ditch or edgestitch and quarter inch foot.

Place mats: painters tape
