Provided -

Fabrics; blue, greens, tans, birch trees, stone wall, 3-5 spring tulip colors
Wonder Under (pre-applied to all fabrics)
7" x 9" backing and lining
8" x 10" art frame
10½" x 12½" green fabric to cover art frame
Parchment paper for ironing
Irons and boards

Need to Bring - (Sewing machine (with open toe or free motion foot, and regular foot)

Large glue stick (e.g.: Craft Bond, Extra Strength)

Tacky/fabric glue

Scissors – small and sharp for fussy cutting (e.g.: Karen Kay Buckley 3 ¾" curved)
Rotary cutter – 30mm
Tweezers
Rotary cutter and mat (I have some loaners)
Black sharpie permanent marker-fine tip or pencil
Thread

- white or lt. blue - variegated green - white bobbin thread
- dark tan - chartreuse green - black bobbin thread
- black - sage green
- gray or variegated zebra - grass green
- dark salmon, wheat yellow, dk. pink, and tulip red for tulips

Optional:

Quilting gloves
Quilting ruler
Erasable marker; (eg:Pilot Ball Frixion)
