Embroidery machine in good working order with cord and foot pedal

Basic sewing supplies (pins, scissors, seam ripper, bobbins, etc.)

Machine Needle Type: 75/11 Embroidery

Thread Type(s): Embroidery Thread

Hoops: Oval Hoop

Book or pattern: Fall in Love by Janine Babich

Hoops: 6"x10"

Interfacing Requirements: 3"x9" fusible web

Poly Mesh stabilizer

Crisp tear way

1/4" steam A Seam tape 12"

Fabric requirements: 1/3 yd. background fabric

3-3" squares of fabric for the appliqued leaves

Batting requirements: 1/4 yd. fusible fleece (Pellon Thermolam Plus TP9711F recommended)

Notions: Embroidery thread to coordinate with chosen fabrics

12" of 1/2" or 5/8" grosgrain ribbon

1 - Trip Tic wire stand

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October - Scarecrow Table Center

Book or pattern: Scarecrow Table Center by Sweet Pea

Rotary cutter, mat and ruler

Iron and pressing pad

Oval Hoop & Maxi Hoop

Interfacing Requirements: Poly mesh stabilizer enough for 6 hoopings

Fabric requirements: 5" x5" Fabric for background 7"x7" 3 for the pumpkin panel and 2 for the scarecrow panel

6"x6" Fabric for background 8"x8" 3 for the pumpkin panel and 2 for the scarecrow panel

7"x7" Fabric for background 9"x9" 3 for the pumpkin panel and 2 for the scarecrow panel

Small pieces of fabric for the leaf, shirt, face and hat

Small piece for the pumpkin

Fabric for backing

Batting requirements: 5"x5" - 7"x7" piece of batting

6"x6" - 8"x8" piece of batting

7"x7" - 9"x9" piece of batting

Notions: Embroidery thread to coordinate with fabric for appliques

November - Greeting Collection 1

Book or pattern: Greetings Collection 1 by Smith Street Designs

Embroidery machine in good working order with cord and foot pedal

Interfacing Requirements: Heavyweight cut-away stabilizer

Fabric requirements: Scraps of fabrics for appliques

Notions:

Fusible web

Temporary adhesive spray

Double sided adhesive tape

Blank cards - 5"x6 7/8"

Envelopes - standard size 7A, 5 1/4" x 7 1/4"

Fabric scissors and embroidery scissors

Paper for inside of card

Small iron

For the Celebrate card you will need 3 - 1/2" buttons

December - Holiday Stars

Book or pattern: Holiday Stars by Poorhouse Quilt Designs

Hoops: Oval Hoop

Interfacing Requirements: Medium weight Tear-away Stabilizer

Pellon Decor Bond

Fabric requirements: 1 fat quarter

Notions: Embroidery Thread, Thread to match fabric

Embroidery floss or narrow ribbon for hanging

Buttons, sequines, 4mm crystals (optional embellishments)
