



Intro to Thread Painting

with Alison Zeerip

This fun and relaxing technique allows you to create your own masterpieces with thread. A little or a lot of painting, the choice is yours! We will be learning thread painting techniques by using exercises to demonstrate, learn, and practice so that you feel confident and can use what you've learned on your own masterpieces. Isacord thread will be available for use and feel free to bring any specialty thread you may have to try with this great technique!

Thread is not included in the kit; however, I am happy to assist students by appointment if they would like to bring in project before class day and help individualize thread choices for their project of choice.

The kit for Thread Painting is \$25.00 and includes:

Fusible batting approximately 18" x 44"

(2) 1/2 yard cuts of background quilter's cotton for sandwich front and back

Batik fabric for shapes for "painting"

Lite Steam a Seam II to affix shapes to sandwich to "paint"

Parchment Paper

Cardstock for templates for shapes

Classroom collection of Isacord thread to use for "painting" in class.

Additional Items to Bring:

90/14 Topstitch or Embroidery needles for your sewing machine.

Fabric safe marking utensils for light and dark fabrics (Bohin, chalk, graphite pencil etc.)

Sewing Machine in good working order with ability to drop your feed dogs and several (at least 3) empty bobbins

Sewing machine with needle down position available strongly recommended

Applique &/or clear or large opening free motion foot & open toe foot for sewing machine

Isacord or similar that you have and would like to bring, preferably with a light, medium, and dark would be great. If you have embroidery thread at home and have colors you like in a light, medium, and dark--bring those color sets to class as well.

Seam ripper

Thread snips, curved preferred to clip close to the quilt top.
