Enjoy making these bright poppies on a table runner using raw edge applique. The background is simply pieced and provides for increased interest. We will utilize Steam-a-Seam II Lite to build our poppies. This is a great project to use our Ombre batiks for several color values using one

piece of fabric. Use of batik or dyed fabric for this project is encouraged to decrease potential for a visible white line edge if using printed fabric. We will focus on top construction only in class.

Supply list:

Book or pattern: Poppies by Wildfire Designs Alaska by Dana Michelle

Sewing machine in good working order with cord and foot pedal

Basic sewing supplies (pins, scissors, seam ripper, bobbins, etc.)

Rotary cutter, mat and ruler

Iron and pressing pad

Machine Needle Type: 80/12 Topstitch and 80/12 Microtex

Thread Type(s): 50 wt Aurifil or similar

Interfacing Requirements: Steam-a-Seam II Lite

Fabric requirements: See pattern back for table runner and may change according to color choices.

Batting requirements: 1/2 yard of 45" or wider of thin batting such as Warm and White.

Notions: 1/4 inch foot for sewing machine

Non-stick pressing or Applique sheet or parchment paper to build flowers on

****Bringing own small iron and pressing surface may be helpful to decrease wait time for pressing station.**

Chalk marker

****Bring your own cutting mat, rotary cutter and ruler to make accurate fabric strips to sew and sub-cut for background construction.**
